Regulations on application and award procedure for the artist's studio AKKU

Who is entitled to apply?

- creative artists from the fields of visual arts, Swiss or foreign, who devote themselves to artistic creation professionally and principally
- personal application only / no representation by galleries, please

What the award includes:

- six month stay in the artist's studio, beginning in January or July
- possibility to live in the studio (very basic facilities, cf. description of studio)
- exhibition in the art container at the end of the stay
- financial support for a catalogue / **a work of art**
- no expenses paid for travel and cost of living

What is expected of the artist:

- by applying the artist agrees to be prepared to start the stay and to be present in Uster for at least 2/3 of the time
- at the end of the year the artist is expected to have created a work of art in multiple form (like a print in size A4) as a gift for the members of the society (expenses will be paid)
